

Descendants of John Bone

Generation One

1. John¹ BONE; born circa 1733;¹ married Mary Baker, daughter of Moses Baker and Ann Othen, 4 May 1760 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England; both aged 26 years;^{2,3} died by his own hand Jul 1788 at Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England;^{4,5} buried 19 Jul 1788 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England.⁶

Mary BAKER^{7,8} was born circa 1734.¹ She was baptized on 11 Oct 1738 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England.⁶ She died on 21 Nov 1807 at Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England.^{9,10} She was buried on 22 Nov 1807 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England, as the widow of John, aged 73.^{6,11} Up to her death in 1807, Mary a.k.a. the Widow Bone received aid from Froyle Parish for distress and illness.¹²

Children of John¹ Bone and Mary Baker all born at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England, were as follows:

- vi. Esther Bone; christened 21 Dec 1772;¹³ married John Oliver 20 Jul 1793 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England.¹⁴
3. vii. Lucy Bone, christened 24 Mar 1775; married Henry Combs.
- viii. John Bone; christened 4 May 1778;⁶ died Apr 1821 at England at age 42;¹⁵ buried 22 Apr 1821 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England, aged 43 years.⁶
- ix. James Bone; christened 9 May 1781.⁶
- x. William Bone; christened 16 Oct 1785; where name may have been misspelled BOON, and corrected to BONE.⁶

Generation Two

2. Ann² BONE;^{16,17} christened 7 Mar 1768 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England;^{13,6} died Jun 1805 at age 37;¹⁸ buried 9 Jun 1805 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England, aged 37.⁶

She and Thomas Reading were associated in 1793; and had a child out of wedlock, Thomas Reading Bone, born 14 Jul 1793.¹⁹

Thomas READING. There was a Thomas Reading recorded in a marriage to Sarah Dicker in Froyle, 12 Nov 1792. It appears they had five children in Buriton: Hannah, Frances, George, John and James Reading; and that they were in Petersfield by 1809.^{6,20} He was living in 1793 at Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England.²¹

Children of Ann² Bone and Thomas Reading were:

4. i. Thomas Reading³ Bone, christened 14 Jul 1793 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England; married Elizabeth Albery.

3. Lucy² BONE; christened 24 Mar 1775 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England;¹³ married Henry Combs 7 Mar 1795 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England;¹⁴ died Oct 1835 at age 60;²² buried 25 Oct 1835 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England.⁶

It appears that several of Lucy's decedents remained in Froyle.²³

Henry COMBS was christened on 2 Aug 1766 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England; son of Thomas Coombs and Mary.⁶ He died in Dec 1847 at age 81.²⁴ He was buried on 4 Dec 1847 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England.⁶

Children of Lucy² Bone and Henry Combs all born at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England, were as follows:

- i. Hannah³ Combs;^{25,25} christened 16 Jul 1797.²⁵
- ii. Richard Combs;^{6,6} born 5 Jul 1801.⁶
- iii. Sarah Combs;^{25,25} christened 2 Mar 1806.²⁵
- iv. Lucy Combs;^{25,25} christened 27 Oct 1811;²⁵ died Nov 1811;²⁶ buried 1 Dec 1811 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England.⁶
- v. William Combs;^{6,6} christened 8 Nov 1812.⁶

Generation Three

4. Thomas Reading³ BONE;^{27,28} christened 14 Jul 1793 at St. Mary's Upper Froyle, Froyle, Co. Hampshire, England; described in baptismal record as 'baseborn' son of anne;^{6,29} married Elizabeth Albery, daughter of James Albery and Frances Poling, 11 Oct 1830 at Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England; witnessed by Martha Albery. Elizabeth Albery's parents were recorded, but Thomas's were not. Thomas was a master brewer, and made his mark with an 'x'. Elizabeth signed her name;^{30,31} died "aged 69 years... His end was peace" 13 Jul 1862 at age 68;³² buried 18 Jul 1862 at Petersfield Cemetery, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England, "age 69, unconsecrated ground, section KK", where the stone reads "His end was peace."^{33,32,34}

In 1805 and 1807, Thomas' mother and then grandmother died. His whereabouts between 1807 and 1821 are unknown. Thomas' uncle John lived until 1820, in Froyle.³⁵ On 21 Feb 1821, Thomas Bone was admitted to the Church of Christ (Independent), College Street, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire.³⁶ It is likely that Thomas was acquainted with James Albery, a senior maltster on College St., Petersfield. Thomas was also a maltster, attended the same church as James' daughter Elizabeth from 1829, and married her in 1830.³⁷ He was a maltster between 1832 and 1859.^{38,39} He and Elizabeth Albery appeared on the census of 1841 at College Street, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England; where Thomas (~45) a maltster, Elizabeth (~45), Mary Ann (9), Emma (5),

and Harry (4) were present. All declared born Co. Hampshire.^{40,41} He and Elizabeth Albery appeared on the census of Mar 1851 at College Street, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England; where Thomas (57) was a maltster and brewer, born in Froyle. Elizabeth (58) was born in Petersfield. Mary Anne (18), Emma (15) and Harry Albery (14) were also present.^{42,43} He and Elizabeth Albery appeared on the census of Mar 1861 at College Street, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England; where Thomas (67) was a maltster. Elizabeth (68), and Harry (24) were present (but Mary Ann and Emma were not).^{42,44}

Elizabeth ALBERY; whose name was also spelled Albury and Alberr^{45,46} was born on 29 Mar 1793 at Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England.^{47,48} She was baptized on 25 Apr 1793 at St. Peter's, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England.^{49,48} She died of cold weather and old age on 6 Feb 1879 at Steep, Co. Hampshire, England, at age 85.⁵⁰ She was buried on 8 Feb 1879 at Petersfield Cemetery, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England, "Elizabeth Bone of Sheet age 85, unconsecrated section (K)."^{51,52} Elizabeth was admitted to the Church of Christ (Independent), College Street, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, on 2 Jan 1829.⁵³ She appeared on the census of 1871 at 2 St. Mary's Terrace, Sheet St., Sheet, Co. Hampshire, England; where Elizabeth (78) was a widow.⁵⁴

Children of Thomas Reading³ Bone and Elizabeth Albery all born at Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England, were as follows:

- i. Mary Ann⁴ Bone; born 14 Dec 1832;⁵⁵ baptized 13 Jan 1833 at Church Of Christ (Independent), Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England;^{56,55} married Charles Lillywhite 11 Feb 1858 at Congregational Chapel, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England; witnessed by Thomas Bone, who signed his name;⁵⁰ died where age recorded as 66 yrs 5 Oct 1898 at Yew Villa, Steep, Co. Hampshire, England, at age 65;^{50,57,58} buried 7 Oct 1898 at Steep Churchyard, Steep, Co. Hampshire, England, "65, of Yew Villa, Steep."^{50,58}

She and Charles Lillywhite appeared on the census of 1861 at Steep, Co. Hampshire, England; where Charles was a Miller (31 yrs), born Ropley. Mary Ann, wife (28), born Petersfield.⁵⁹ She and Charles Lillywhite lived in 1861 at Yew Villa, Steep, Co. Hampshire, England.⁶⁰ She and Charles Lillywhite appeared on the census of 1881 at Sheet Bridge Mill, Steep, Co. Hampshire, England; where Charles (59) was a miller, and Mary Ann (48) and servant Mary Gillman (26) were present.⁶¹ The Lillywhite's house at Steep remained at least until the end of the 20th Century, being considerably enlarged, and now known as Elmwood.⁶²

- ii. Emma Bone; born 29 Aug 1835;⁶³ baptized 11 Nov 1835 at Church Of Christ (Independent), Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England; where mother's name recorded as Elizabeth Albery (instead of Albury as found on sibling Mary and Harry's christening records);^{56,63} died of consumption 7 Aug 1853 at Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England, at age 17.⁶⁴
- iii. Harry Albery Bone;^{65,66} born 27 Feb 1837;^{67,68} baptized 23 Apr 1837 at Petworth, Co. Sussex, England;^{56,69} married Kate Stallard, daughter of Edward George James Stallard and Ann Chalcraft, 28 Sep 1861 at Congregational Chapel, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England; when Harry was recorded to be 24 and a Maltster in Petersfield, and Kate 18 years of age in Sheet, witnessed by Edward Stallard (Kate's father) and Frances Stallard (her sister);⁷⁰ died 15 Dec 1912 at 185 Fern Avenue, Toronto, York Co., Ontario, Canada, at age

75;^{71,67} buried 18 Dec 1912 at St. George's On-The-Hill, Range 9 North, S 1/2 lot 16, plot 3, Etobicoke, Ontario, Canada.^{72,67}

Harry may have attended Churcher's College sometime between 1847 and 1858. He later told how he could pick from his father's apple trees reaching over the fence from the school yard. He may instead have attended the British boys and girls school on College Street.⁷³ He was a Master Brewer and beer retailer in 1865 at College Street, Petersfield, Co. Hampshire, England.^{74,75} He and Kate Stallard emigrated circa 1867 to Canada; Possibly the Bones first settled in Islington, Ontario (prob. with the Stallards in 1867) -- just west of Toronto, then moved on to St. Joseph, Missouri, and then returned to Allandale and Barrie by 1880.^{42,76,77}
